- **Strong caddie record:** Applicants must have caddied, successfully and regularly, for a minimum of two years and are also expected to caddie and/or work at their sponsoring club during the summer when they apply for the scholarship.
- **Excellent academics:** Applicants must have completed their junior year of high school with above a B average in college preparatory courses and are required to take the ACT.
- **Demonstrated financial need:** Applicants must clearly establish their need for financial assistance.
- **Outstanding character:** Applicants must be outstanding in character, integrity and leadership

We are hiring caddies who are motivated, interested, and available to caddie from the end of the 20/21 school year until the start of the 21/22 school year. Are you able to commit to this program 5 days per week during this period of time?

Depending on which clubs have assignments for the caddies on that particular day, the schedule will vary so that some days you will have morning loops (rounds of 18 holes) while some days you will have afternoon loops (rounds of 9 holes). Are you able to allow for that kind of flexibility each day?

What goals do you have this summer? Not only for caddying but your summer goals in general?

Do you participate in sports? If yes, which one(s)? When does your season run – start to finish date?

Do you have any vacations, summer camps, or any other commitments planned? If so, when are they?

Do you have any physical conditions that would prevent you from being able to carry a 35-pound golf bag for approximately 5 ½ miles over a 4-hour period over hilly terrain and all types of weather?

Transportation to and from the pick-up point is an important factor for caddies. What will be your primary transportation method? (Car, mom, dad, sibling, walking, bike, ride share, other?)

Grades are a critical component and a core value of any caddie. We are wanting your caddie experience to complement your education. Please provide the name, phone number, and email of your school guidance counselor whom we can contact to discuss your academic achievements.

At the end of the summer, we will be requiring caddies selected for the program to write detailed and sincere thank-you notes to sponsors of the Caddie Academy. Why do you think this is an important task?

The Evans Scholarship (www.wgaesf.org) is a four-year, full-tuition college scholarship that is awarded to high school seniors who have caddied full-time for at least two summers, have achieved good grades, have outstanding character, and whose families have financial need.
